1. How do we participate?

Participants must register through the Port Huron Parks and Recreation website at www.porthuronrec.com. After registration you will receive our Watershed Challenge Checklist and information to help you complete the first category – Explore! Throughout the 12-week challenge you will receive more information about each activity and suggestions for ways to complete them.

2. How do we complete the Watershed Challenge?

The challenge is considered completed when you complete two activities from each of the six categories: Explore, Do, Learn, Share, Act and Make. By December 12th, twelve activities must be completed. Bonus activities can be used to substitute a task if needed.

3. How do we prove we completed each challenge?

We would love to receive photos or descriptions of your adventures; however, we understand that may not work for everyone. At the very least, please mark off the challenges you complete and send us a picture of or mail in your completed checklist.
